Roles of a Pharmacy Technician

- · Fill prescriptions: dispense meds to be verified by the pharmacist
- Handle insurance: verify insurance of patient
- · Customer service: interact with patients daily

How to get Licensed - path 1

- · Qualify to take the PTCE
 - O Take a course or work 500 hours
- · Apply and take the PTCE
 - O Preparation is the KEY
- · Apply for license
 - Get licensed by the CA State Board of Pharmacy
- · Work and renew license
 - Licenses need to be renewed every 2 years

How to get Licensed - path 2

- Work for 240 hours
 - O Work in a pharmacy instead of taking the PTCE
- · Apply for license
 - O Get certified by the CA State Board of Pharmacy
- · Work and renew license
 - O Licenses need to be renewed every 2 years

Applying and Prepping for the PTCE

- PTCE recognized education/training program for completion within 60 days
 - O Can apply for the exam while you are doing the program
 - There are online and in-person courses
- Or equivalent work experience as a pharmacy technician (min 500 hours)

How to Apply and What to Expect on Exam Day

- · Applying
 - Oreqte an account on http://www.ptcb.org/
 - Order the exam, cost \$129
 - Only in-person
 - Once approved, email is sen to schedule exam date
- · Exam Day
 - O Arrive and check in at least 30 min early

- O Bring an approved form of ID
- O Preliminary exam result shows on screen immediately after your test
 - Official test results posted online 1-3 weeks later

Exam Details

- 90 multiple choice questions (10 unscored)
 - You won't know which questions are unscored
- 2 hours to complete exam (includes a 5 min tutorial + 5 min post-survey)
- Passing score = 1400
 - O Score is between 1000-1600
- · All the questions are weighted differently from each other

Topics Covered in PTCE

- 40% medications
- · 26.25% patient safety and quality assurance
- 21.25% order entry and processing
- 12.5% federal requirements

License

- State Board of Pharmacy
 - O Application fee of \$195 made to the Board of Pharmacy
 - O Pharmacy Technician Application
 - Download from pharmacy.ca.gov
 - O SSN or Taxpayer ID Number
 - A passport style photo
 - Taken within 60 days of filling the application
 - O Proof of education
 - Official high school transcript
 - O PTCB Certification
 - Download from PTCB website
 - O Self Query Report
 - Obtain from NPDB
 - Fee required
 - O Fingerprint Live Scan receipt
 - Taken within 60 days of filling the application
 - Application may take up to 45 days to be processed

License Renewal

- CphTs are required to renew certification every 2 years
- · Renewal application opens 60 days before certification expiration date
- Renew by continuing education: Complete a minimum of 20 hours of Continuing Education (CE)
- Renewal fee: \$194
 - You can renew online or by mail
