What is Pharmacy?

- The practice of preparation and dispensing of medicinal drugs
- Pertains to a lot than this definition
- Known to dispense medicine and prescriptions
- Conduct health and wellness screenings
- · Compounding

What is PharmO?

- O Doctor of Pharmacy, professional doctorate degree
- O Necessary if you want to be pharmacists

Pharmo vs Pho

- PharmD program is more for people who want to be come pharamcists
- PhD program is more for people who want to purse a career in research
- Can both be acquired to do research in pharmacy

Careers in Pharmacy

- O Not all careers in pharmacy require PharmD or PhD (e.g. Pharmacy Technician)
- O Community Pharamcists
 - Work in retail pharmacies (e.g. CVS and Walgreens)
 - Prepare and dispense prescriptions
- O Clinical Pharmacists
 - Work in healthcare settings (e.g. hospitals, clinics)
 - Collaborate with other healthcare providers
