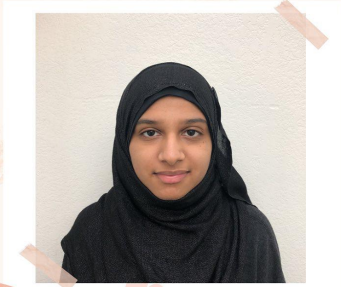

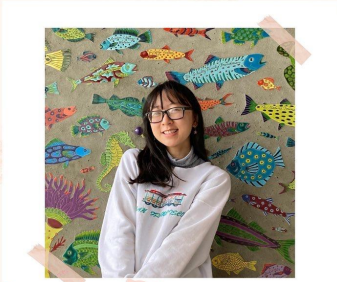

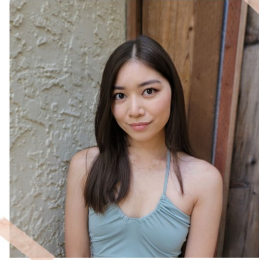

Key points:

- The rapid growth rate in Omicron infections is believed to result from a combination of increased transmissibility and the ability to evade immunity conferred by past infection or vaccination (i.e., immune evasion)
- Although existing vaccines do not fully protect people from Omicron infections, they help to alleviate severe illness and symptoms. Vaccinations and boosters are strongly recommended.

Pfizer, BioNTech Say 3 Doses of COVID-19 Vaccine 'Neutralize' Omicron Variant

- Key points:
 - New data from Pfizer and BioNTech demonstrate that 3 doses of the COVID-19 vaccine successfully neutralize the Omicron variant, whereas 2 doses show significantly reduced neutralization titers
 - A booster shot increases an individual's antibody titers 25x and increases CD8 T cell levels against multiple spike protein epitopes
 - Development of a vaccine specific to the Omicron variant began on November 25th and are expected to be delivered within 100 days



COVID Antiviral Pill

- Short summary:
 - Pfizer's Paxlovid and Merck's molnupiravir are both oral antiviral pills that can be taken at home to keep patients out of the hospital. They're meant to be taken within the first few days of having COVID-19, and they reduce the risk of hospitalization and death by up to 88% for Paxlovid and 30% for molnupiravir.
 - These pills have just been authorized for emergency use (FDA authorized before dec 25) and are currently only used for patients high risk for developing severe COVID-19 illness
 - But plans for drug distribution varies a lot among different states since the drug is quite scarce still, very hard find pill around pharmacies
